#### Protect Our Pipes – Think Before You Flush

We want to remind everyone that toilets are not trash cans. Flushing non-flushable items like wipes (even those labeled "flushable"), paper towels, feminine hygiene products, diapers, grease, and other household waste can lead to serious blockages in the sewer system. These blockages not only cause environmental harm and system damage, but they can also lead to sewer backups and costly repairs. If inappropriate materials are traced back to a specific property, the responsible party may be held liable for the cost of repairs and cleanup. Please do your part to keep our wastewater system flowing smoothly — only flush toilet paper and human waste.

## RV Parking Rules in the City of Kooskia 1. General Rule:

You're not allowed to live in a travel trailer, tent trailer, motor home, 5<sup>th</sup> wheel or recreational vehicle outside of a trailer park or mobile home subdivision—unless there's a specific exception

2.Exception for Primary Residence:
If you apply and get permission from the Kooskia City Council, you can keep one occupied RV or trailer on your own property as your main home but it must be connected to city water and sewer services.
