## CITY OF KOOSKIA HAPPENINGS

The City of Kooskia is conducting a capital improvements project to replace aging sewer mains and improve the reliability of the City's sewage lift stations. These improvements will be occurring from the Summer of 2023 to Spring of 2024.The project has been engineered by Mountain Waterworks and is being constructed by M2 Construction. You may be seeing paint marks on the ground and construction equipment near your home or place of business. These crews will be excavating and replacing sewer lines and manholes in these areas. #### UTILITY RATE INCREASE

With an approximate increase of 2.8% in sewer, a 1.9% in wastewater and a 4.5% increase in garbage you will notice an overall approximate increase of 2.22% increase on utility bills that will be reflected on your Oct. 2023 bill. Water rates are not changing. The current domestic rate without water overage is \$90.00. Effective Oct.1, 2023 it will be \$92.00. For commercial rates please call city hall @ 208-926-4684

How to Register

It's easy to get started. If you've never registered before, registration is fast and convenient. You'll need your Name as it appears on your bill, your billing address, your Account Number as it appears on your bill, and your email address. You'll create your own personal Username and Password and, when completed, a confirmation email will be sent to you indicating that you are now registered. Once registered, all you'll need is your Username and Password to access your account. This is a Convenience Fee-based service. The convenience fee is collected by a third-party payment processor and that fee is used to pay the credit card processing fees and the cost of operating the payment website. The City does not collect any of the Convenience Fees.

The City does not collect or retain any personal financial information with this website as that process is entirely handled by The Payment Group/ PAYA through its secure payment processing portal.
